




# ONE OF THE MOST STUNNING AND VIBRANT LOCATIONS IN THE WORLD


With a land area of 124,450 square kilometres, Sarawak is the largest state in Malaysia and makes up over 37% of Malaysia's total land area. Sarawak has tracts of tropical virgin rainforests which are home to an abundance of plants such as the Rafflesia tuan-mudae and pitcher plants, and animal species such as the Orangutan, Proboscis Monkey and Brooke butterfly.

The Rajang River sprawls out for 563 kilometres, making it the longest river in Malaysia. Sarawak also boasts the world's most extensive cave system in Gunung Mulu National Park, which is recognised as a UNESCO World

Heritage Site and remains the most studied tropical karst area in the world. Sarawak has some of the world's oldest rainforests, and discovered within Niah Cave was evidence of the earliest known existence of man in Southeast Asia.

With a population of 2.6 million people, Sarawak is home to 28 different ethnic groups, each with their own distinct language, culture and lifestyle, living together in harmony with a common sense of Sarawak pride.




# **ABOUT BCCK**



The Borneo Convention Centre Kuching (BCCK) is the first international purpose-built convention centre in Sarawak, Malaysia. Growing alongside Sarawak's position as a captivating culture, adventure and nature destination on the exotic island of Borneo, the BCCK debuted in 2009, as a state initiative of the Sarawak Government to grow business tourism through the hosting of business events.

Situated on the Kuching Isthmus and ringed by the Sarawak River, the BCCK is approximately fifteen minutes' drive from the city centre and twenty minutes' drive from the Kuching International Airport.



# **Centre Guide - Directory At A Glance**

Our flexible facilities provide the perfect setting for any event, from a convention for 5,000 people to an intimate dinner for 2 people. With more than 3,740 sq m of highly flexible function space, our facility spans across the building and is designed as a series of modules that can be combined or divided to suit the needs of any event you can imagine.





#### Great Hall

The Great Hall has the capacity for 4,656 delegates and can be subdivided into 4 self-contained meeting areas.

#### Capacity

Tiered + Flat Floor Seating - 4,556 delegates.



#### Meeting Room 6

With a floorspace of 97.75m<sup>2</sup>, this meeting room is fully equipped with a range of in-built audiovisual and communication facilities.

Meeting rooms 8 + 9 combined offer a flexible meeting space of 144.5m<sup>2</sup>

- The Great Hall can accommodate up to 4,556 delegates for a conference or 2,000 guests for a banqueting function.
- 14 Meeting Rooms with various capacities can accommodate from 30 to 375 delegates or up to 1,014 delegates when combined.
- Car parking is available for 800 vehicles in a combination of underground and open parking spaces. In addition there is a coach drop off point for 5 coaches plus ample coach parking lots.
- The Raintree Restaurant, with un-spoilt views over the Sarawak River and mangrove swamps, offers a fine dining experience for delegates, exhibitors and visitors. The Restaurant sits 120 pax comfortably with 80 pax indoors and 40 pax outdoors.
- We also provide uninterrupted wireless services for up to 8,000 users simultaneously.
